

GCC Power undersecretaries finalize 18-item draft to improve electricity

KUWAIT - Kuwaiti Undersecretary of Minister of Electricity and Water Ahmad Al-Jassar said Monday that the undersecretaries of Electricity in GCC countries have finalized an 18-items draft crafted particularly for improving energy services and ready to be submitted to GCC ministers for final approval tomorrow.

After heading the Kuwaiti delegation in meetings for the GCC undersecretaries of electricity, Al-Jassar said in a press release that the 18 items aims at enhancing the quality of electricity services presented by the ministry of electricity.

The official noted that among the most predominant issues will be the GCC power link grid and the budget for the project.

Other item on the draft has to do with the enhancing on the quality of water resources and industrial waste, including setting up legislations and regulations concerning the organization of power utilization in GCC countries.

With regard to discussions in the meetings, Al-Jassar said that the purpose of such discussions was to find ways to enhance the welfare of GCC citizens, including finding a better way to consume and rationalize power consumption.
