

# Oman approves \$150m in publically funded projects

Oman's tender board has approved another \$150m in publically funded projects.

The new projects include the construction of bridges for Iteen street cross-section with Al Ribat street and the expansion of Al Ribat street in Salalah (\$54m) and the upgrade of the Jahlout Power Plant to 220/132 KV and the associated transmission line 220 KV (\$47m).

A further contract for security services for the Public Authority for Electricity and Water in regions and governorates, valued at \$9.9m, was also signed, as was another for the supply of SBA-1 catalyst for Oman Refineries and Petrochemicals Company (\$7.7m)

The remaining contracts include the \$6.5m design and implementation of Al Saihara road in Sohar and the construction of wastewater treatment plant in Duqm, valued at \$3.6m.
